Erzähler: *The next afternoon they go to Loch Ness again.

The three kangaroos fall asleep and dream of Nessie.*

Erzähler: *The next day they are sitting at the breakfast table.*
William: *Let's go back home. We'll never see Nessie!*
Robert: *I want to go home, too.*
